

Camp Fires

Recommendations:

1. Burning Permit required.
2. Only one (1) campfire shall be permitted on a property at a time (professional organized groups only).
3. For campground, both private and public, each individual camping lot shall be considered a separate property.
4. All campfires shall be contained using a non-combustible material, which shall prevent the accidental spread of fire.
5. Campfires shall not exceed 24 inches (600mm) in width and wood not to be piled more than 18 inches (460mm) in height.
6. Clearance of 15 feet (4.57 meters) must be maintained in all directions.
7. Only dry seasoned firewood shall be used.
8. Fire must not be left unattended and all embers must be extinguished with water when burning is completed.
9. No burning will take place when the Department of Natural Resources has banned all open fire burning.

Bon Fires

Recommendations:

1. Burning permit required.
2. Only one (1) bon fire shall be permitted on a property at a time.
3. Burning shall be restricted to the beach.
4. Fires shall not exceed 36 inches in diameter and 30 inches in height.
5. Clearance of 20 feet from combustibles must be maintained in all directions.
6. There shall be no use of treated wood, painted wood, leaves, grass, or other vegetation, plastic, oil, rubber or food materials.
7. Fire must not be left unattended and all embers must be extinguished with water when burning is completed.
8. No fire shall be ignited when the wind is blowing of sufficient velocity that it may jeopardize the ability to control the fire.
9. No burning shall take place when Department of Natural Resources has banned all open fire burning.
