DESCRIPTION:

Performs work related to Planning and Development for the Planning department and Engineering Services. Creates and maintains Geographic Information Systems (GIS) databases. Provides GIS training and technical support to City department. Compiles data including aerial photography, survey notes, records, reports, and original maps to ensure completeness and accuracy. Acts as liaison between consultants, the City and the public. Provides as-built information for capital projects upon request. Provides sketches and diagrams subject to the approval for the Director of Engineering Services and modifies plans.

Monday to Friday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (40 hours/week).
