

In accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of the Collective agreement between C.U.P.E. Local 550 and the City of Bathurst, the following vacancy is hereby posted:

SWING OPERATOR-WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT

DESCRIPTION:

Reporting to their immediate supervisor, the swing operator Waste Water Treatment Plant operator is responsible for the maintenance of the Waste Water Treatment Plant, and persons entering the grounds as per SOPs in the absence of regular operators.

SHIFTS:

See article 22.09 of the Collective Agreement.

WAGES:

Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator rate while performing those functions – as per Collective Agreement.

LENGTH OF TRIAL PERIOD:

Sixty (60) days actually worked in the case of vacancies (Article 18.07 (b) (1) and (d)).

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Two (2) years post-secondary education in science or Engineering and approved by the Department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour;
- Sufficient physical and technical ability to perform tasks as required;
- Sufficient computer knowledge and ability to operate SCADA as well as maintenance management systems, work order systems, etc.;
- Familiar with mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems;
- Confined Space Entry and Rescue Certification;
- Must attain training and level requirements as outlined in the job description for Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator.
