Reporting to their immediate supervisor, the swing operator Water Treatment Plant operator is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Water Treatment Plant, and persons entering the grounds, as per Standard Operating Procedures, in the absence of regular operators.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Two (2) years post-secondary education in science or Engineering and approved by the department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour;
- Sufficient physical and technical ability to perform tasks as required;
- Sufficient computer knowledge and ability to operate SCADA, Arc view or current GIS technology of the corporation as well as maintenance management systems, work order systems, etc.;
- Familiar with mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems;
- Confined Space Entry and Rescue Certification;
- Must attain training and level requirements as outlined in the job description for Water Treatment Plant Operator.
