POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the direction and guidance of the Fire Chief, the Deputy Fire Chief - Operations ensures the department operates in compliance with federal, provincial, and municipal legislation, while maintaining a strong focus on firefighter safety, community risk reduction, personnel development, and continuous improvement. This position plays a critical role in strategic direction, operational management, and administrative oversight of all fire containment, emergency medical response, technical rescue, hazardous materials response, fire prevention, public education, and emergency preparedness programs across the municipality or the Chaleur region.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree in Fire Science, Public Administration, Emergency Management, Business Administration or a related field from a recognized institution.
- Completion of a provincial or municipal Firefighter Training Program (as authorized by the Department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour).
- Completion of Incident Command System (ICS) courses: ICS 100, 200 and 300, required for Emergency Measure Operations (EMO):
- Minimum of ten (10) years of experience as a full-time Firefighter.
- Ability to develop solutions to complex problems and implement data-driven Management approaches;
- Incident Command training and experience. Completion of Incident Command System courses: ICS 100, 200 and 300, required for Emergency Measure Operations;
- Strong leadership, interpersonal relations, planning, critical thinking and problem solving skills;
- Strong conflict resolution skills with proven experience resolving complex and sensitive issues in a unionized environment;
- Ability to communicate fluently in both official languages (oral and written, in English and French) is required;
- Local assistant designation by the Fire Marshal's office is required; Fire Inspector 1 "NFPA 1031", "2014" certification is considered an asset;
- Experience in working with both volunteer firefighters and career firefighters considered an asset.
