BATHURST SPORTS HALL OF FAME Nomination Criteria

- No more than three (3) candidates shall be inducted in the induction year.
- The induction ceremony is typically held every two (2) years.
- There are two (2) main categories: (ensure to choose the correct nomination form based on nominee)
 - 1. <u>Individual</u>: Individuals who have attained exceptional success in sport as a single sport or multisport. Individuals who have made a significant contribution to their sport as a competitor, coach, volunteer, manager, trainer or other.
 - 2. **Team**: Sports team that has attained exceptional success in sport.
- Any nominees who, by outstanding achievement, have attained prominence in any field of sport or
 who have made a major contribution to the development and advancement of sport in Bathurst are
 eligible for selection to the Bathurst Sports Hall of Fame.
- Candidates for selection shall be chosen based on playing ability, sportsmanship, character, their contribution to their particular sport and to sport generally.
- Player candidates must have concluded their careers as active players for a minimum of five (5) years before their selection.¹
- An athlete who has reached his or her 50th birthday will be eligible for nomination, and consideration by the Selection Committee without any waiting period whether or not he or she is still active as a competitor.²
- Individuals that are coaches, managers, volunteers, or trainers may be either active or inactive at the time of their selection.
- Nominations shall be made on official nomination forms and submitted to the Recreation, and Tourism Department and contain the fullest possible data concerning the record and merits of each candidate.
- Forms are available at the Recreation and Tourism Department at the K.C. Irving Regional Centre and as well as online at www.bathurst.ca.
- All forms for nomination must be completed and returned to the Recreation and Tourism Department at the K.C. Irving Regional Centre or by e-mail at recreation@bathurst.ca
- Nominees for induction to the Bathurst Sports Hall of Fame are considered for ten (10) years before being placed in an inactive file.
